Treasurers Report:

Treasurer Harry Breitbach presented copies of the MISGA financial statement dated Nov.30, 1992. There is a net surplus of \$469.64 for fiscal year 1992. Total funds on hand in all accounts were \$18,984.27.

There followed a discussion of the 1993 budget showing a net deficit of \$4200 as presented by outgoing treasurer Sid Rapoport. The budget was adopted as presented. A possible \$.50/person increase in dues may be recommended for adoption in 1994. Associates Report:

Chairman Roy Gauzza reported that there was 30 plus duplications of members within the divisions. He requested that corrections be made and asked that Division Directors decide on one listing for the members in question. He reported that there are 31 new associates listed for 1993 as of 12/2/92.

A discussion followed regarding the desirability of changing our fiscal year to correspond to the calendar year. A motion was passed for the committee to investigate the proposed change and the Board will vote on the proposal prior to the April 19, 1993 meeting. Tournaments:
