We gave no quarter; nor did he. There were numerous wounded vets playing—leg, arm, and hand prostheses were evident. Our service people have a great attitude. We treasure and honor these vets for giving so much for us.

We as a group (MISGA) owe so much, to so few and their families. There is much to be done and as Joe indicated plenty of time for crying a bit, but a lot more time for laughing and forging ahead.
