

## 2010 - MISGA **2-MAN TEAM** CHAMPIONSHIP

**FORMAT: 18-HOLE - STROKE PLAY - NET BEST BALL**

### ELIGIBILITY:

All MISGA Associates in good standing. **Finalists must qualify through their Division's selection process.** Finalists must have an established valid USGA handicap computed and maintained at the finalist's home club.

### HANDICAP ALLOWANCE:

1. 90% of each partner's handicap
2. There will be an additional 10% reduction to each partner's handicap if the partner's handicaps differ by more than 8 strokes.

### TEE PLACEMENT:

**Senior Tee Marker** - normally the forward (*gold*) marker at or about 6,000 yards.

### PRIZES:

1. Approximately 25-30% of the field will receive a Holly Hills Country Club Pro Shop Gift Certificate.
2. The overall 1st place **NET** and **GROSS** finishers will receive an engraved trophy only.
3. 80% of the prize pool will be awarded to the **NET** winners.
4. 20% of the prize pool will be awarded to the **GROSS** winners.

**ENTRY FEE:** *(Instructions for the Division Tournament Chairmen)*

1. The entry fee - **\$95 per person** *(all inclusive)* - includes a light lunch, cart fee, range balls, beverages, awards dinner, prize pool and incidentals.
2. Please submit **one check** for your Division's entrants. If space is available, your alternates will pay at the time of registration.

5. Cancellation Policy - Unless determined otherwise by the *Tournament Committee*,\* no refunds will be granted after Wednesday - August 11, 2010.

## TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:

The tie breaking procedure shall be based on the MISGA mandated match-of-cards for both *low gross* and *low net*. The initial tie-breaker will be the best score attained for the last nine holes (10-18), then the last six holes (13-18), then the last three holes (16-18), and finally the 18th hole. Should a tie still exist, the match will be a hole-by-hole match beginning with the #1 handicap hole and proceeding to the #2 handicap hole and so on until the tie is broken.

## \* TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:

The Tournament Committee will include the host Division Director (*Committee Chairman*), the host Division Tournament Chairman, the host MISGA Club Rep, the host Club Pro, and such other individuals as may be designated by the Division Director. The MISGA Tournament Chairman will assist as needed.

The Tournament Committee will be responsible for establishing the conditions of competition; assuring adherence to USGA, MISGA and local rules of golf; assuring fairness of play and good sportsmanship, interpreting USGA, MISGA and local rules of play; answering technical questions; mediating disputes and resolving other issues and problems as they may occur.

## INTERRUPTED TOURNAMENT:

If, because of unforeseen circumstances (*rain, lightning, flooding, etc.*), the Championship Tournament is interrupted and resumption of play is impossible, the Tournament Committee will declare the Tournament official for determining winners and awarding prizes if all players have completed a minimum of 13 holes. Scores for unplayed holes will be recorded as *par* plus any handicap strokes the player is entitled to receive on the unplayed holes (*this neutralizes all the unplayed holes for all players*). However, if there are any players who have not completed a minimum of 13 holes, a new "stipulated round" should be rescheduled on the "rain date."
