### 2016 - MISGA PAST PRESIDENTS (ABCD) CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

Norbeck Country Club, located in
Rockville, MD, played host to the MISGA
Past Presidents (ABCD) Championship
Tournament. At dawn's early light, 99
greybeard golfers and 1 lady golfer
climbed into their vehicles and hit the
motorways of Maryland, Delaware and
Pennsylvania with hopes of becoming
MISGA's 2016 individual Gross or Net
Grand Champion. They had lofty dreams.

and fire must have had one huge hangover. So huge, he punished the hydrating contestants with sweltering sunshine, high humidity and temperatures in the mid-90s. Fear not. Norbeck *CC* was up to the task. The well manicured tee boxes, fairways, greens and untroublesome roughs were in superb playing condition. From the senior gold tees, the par 72 course measured 5,790 yards with a course rating of 68.1 and a slope of 124. From the ladies' forward *(red)* tees, the course measured 5,452 yards with a course rating of 71.7 and a slope of 124. For the lady golfer, USGA handicap adjustment guidelines were applied. Playing time ranged from "first in" at 4 hours, 50 minutes to "last in" at 5 hours, 45 minutes.

The PP-ABCD tournament was established in 1991 to recognize and honor MISGA's past presidents. These gentlemen devoted much of their time and effort to promote the mission and objectives of our seniors' golfing organization.
